How do I leave a legacy?

If you die without a will, the law decides how your estate will be shared out. Making a will means you decide where the proceeds from your estate will go.

Many solicitors offer a will service or you can make your own basic will by picking up a will template at post offices. It's advisable to have a solicitor check a will to make sure that it is witnessed and valid to ensure your wishes will be carried out.

Jaffray Care specialises in residential care for adults with a variety of learning difficulties, with the benefits extending beyond just those who use our services, to their friends, family and relatives, too.

We work hard to continuously improve the standard of the care that we provide; unfortunately the only limitation that we have is funding.

Just a quick snapshot of some of the work that we do:

- Around 50 clients live permanently in our nursing and residential care homes, which all pride themselves on the high standards of care that they provide.
- In 2010, Jaffray transformed a house in Erdington into 5 high-quality, self-contained, independent-living flats for adults with learning difficulties. This allows these clients to be supported whenever they need, whilst also maintaining the ability to live independently.
- Jaffray, also in 2010, opened a purpose-built 2 story facility for Community services, at the Marsh Lane site. The service promotes equal opportunities for leisure, social and recreational activities for individuals with learning difficulties to develop their skills and confidence, helping them to gain independence and self-esteem.
